What can the Volunteer Program do for ME?

Resource

The Volunteer Office is a central location for obtaining information about volunteering. We partner with volunteer organizations both on and off Base to share their volunteer opportunities with our Camp Pendleton community and to help meet their volunteer needs. Opportunities are posted to the program website, are one-time events or ongoing in nature, and are open to Active Duty, Active Duty Spouses, Active Duty Family Members, Youth, Teens, Retirees, Veterans and Civilians. Unit and group opportunities are also available.

Referral

The Volunteer Program provides one-on-one assistance for individuals who want to learn more about the value of volunteering, and which opportunities are available that fit his/her interests, skills and schedule.

Recordkeeping

The Volunteer Program assists volunteers with volunteer recordkeeping by tracking and reporting volunteer hours. These records are tailored to each volunteer's personal needs and interests.

Recognition

In coordination with the Base Commanding Officer, the Volunteer Program hosts an annual recognition ceremony to honor Camp Pendleton's volunteers, and awards Civilian and Military Volunteer of the Year honors, and Volunteer Unit of the Year honors. The Volunteer Program also recognizes outstanding Volunteer of the Quarter honors. The Volunteer Office assists Active Duty personnel in working towards the Military Outstanding Volunteer Service Medal (MOVSM).
